

## Mug Rugs on Holiday

A quick gift for teachers, friends or yourself!

Mug rugs are basically a place mat for your coffee cup and come in all sizes. This is an easy way to use up scraps too. Directions use the fusible-raw-edge applique method.

Choose to make **either** the hearts or the snowman and bring the appropriate fabric.

**Required Pattern:** Mug rugs on Holiday by Jackie Vujcich

### Fabric scraps needed:

	<b>Hearts</b>	<b>Snowman</b>
Background	8" square	8" square
Border	6"x 10"	6"x 10"
Pinks/reds	4 to 5 diff. 6" squares	
White (head)		5" square
Hat/mittens		2 different 3" x 6"
Orange (nose)		2" x 4"
Batting-	10" square	10" square
Backing	10" square	10" square

**Notions** (besides general sewing and quilting supplies):

Fusible Web (such as Pellon 805 Wonder Under) – ¼ yard

Lt. wt. stabilizer (any type) –8" square

Ribbon (optional) for hearts – 3/8" wide novelty ribbon – 1 spool

Black buttons (snowman) – two ½" diameter, flat (no shank)

Threads- black (for snowman mouth) and other colors to match your fabrics

Small sharp scissors

Glue stick (for hearts)

Applique Pressing Sheet

¼" presser foot & applique presser foot

Rotary cutter and ruler

Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget the foot controller and plug)-it must be capable of sewing an accurate ¼" seam

**Pre-class "homework" instructions:** Prior to class, please cut the following fabric for either mug rug:

Center (background) - Cut one 7 ½" square

Borders – Cut two 1 ½" x 7 ½" rectangles; cut two 1 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles

Batting- Cut one 10" square

Backing - Cut one 10" square
