

Quick Start Quilting for Newbies

Description In this hands-on workshop apply basic techniques to assemble and quilt a table runner or small wall hanging. As you create a small quilt, learn to plan for the project, assemble blocks into the quilt top, and apply quilting and finishing techniques while practicing accuracy skills with quilter tools. This day-long workshop is designed for individuals with confident machine sewing skills but no or little quilting experience.

Prerequisite Confident machine sewer with personal sewing machine in good working condition.

Learner Supplies

- sewing machine and at least two medium sewing machine needles in good working condition
- thread (matching neutral color on spool and bobbin)
- stick pins and/or (optional) quilter clips
- hand-sewing needle
- (optional) cutting mat, minimum size: 24" x 36"
- (optional) rotary cutter, 35 mm blade in good condition
