

## **Carpenter's Wheel Supply List**

Our goal in this class is to finish the quilt top. Time permitting you may be able to layer the quilt and do some simple quilting. Traditionally this star is made with two colors; but we're taking it a step further and expanding to eight!

**Pattern:** Carpenter's Wheel by Jackie Vujcich each student must have their own please

### **Fabric:**

Background and 1<sup>st</sup> Inner border – 1 ¼ yard

2<sup>nd</sup> Middle border- 3/8 yard

3<sup>rd</sup> Outer border – ¾ yards

8 coordinating fabrics- ¼ yard of each (fat quarters work too if length at least 20 ½")

Binding – ½ yard

Batting - 53" x 53"

Backing – 3 yards

### **Notions:**

Sewing Machine in good working order (don't forget the foot controller and plug)

Standard sewing notions

Acrylic rulers 6" x 24"; 6"x6" (or similar size) is optional

Sharp pencil

Mobile design wall OR flannel piece of fabric OR tablecloth with flannel backing (to make a temporary design wall)-very helpful to lay out pieces and decide on color placement

### **Pre-class "homework" instructions:**

Prior to class, you may want to wash your material. Please iron all creases out of your material.
