

**Colorado Escape Follow Up Landscape Quilting**  
**By Jackie Vujcich**

**Supply list (one session)**

In this class please come prepared to quilt your piece of art!

**Required items:**

- 1) Quilt top (COMPLETED), basted and ready to quilt **OR**
- 2) Quilt sandwich” for practice (2 pieces of muslin with a piece of batting in between- about the size of a fat quarter) basted and ready to quilt

**Notions:**

Thread- either monofilament (clear) **OR** colors to match your fabrics (and bobbins too)  
Needles (I use universal size 80- if it breaks too much, try a jean or quilting needle size 90)  
Sewing machine and cords (owner’s manual if not totally familiar with free motion quilting)  
Free motion foot  
Printer paper and pen –about 4-6 sheets so you can practice doodling

**Optional Notions** (nice to have but not absolutely necessary):

Quilting gloves  
Sew Slip quilt mat (or similar product) can find online  
Extension table for your sewing machine

**Pre-class homework:**

It’s my intention that we get right to quilting when class starts. So please have the quilt top completed, layered and basted (strongly suggest a basting spray vs. pins) **BEFORE** class. If you don’t think you can accomplish this prior to class (or would rather practice on something else first), make sure you have a quilt sandwich ready to go.
