

Beginning Quilting – DISAPPEARING NINE-PATCH

Supply List:

- Rotary cutting mat – minimum size 18" x 24"
- Rotary cutter – 45mm or 60mm
- 2 Rotary cutting rulers: 12" square AND 6" x 24"
- Grey sewing thread
- Scissors
- Thread snips
- Pins
- Seam Ripper

Equipment:

- Sewing machine in good working order (that you know how to thread and operate)
- New sewing machine needles, sized 70-80
- ¼" quilting foot

Fabric:

During Class #1 we will discuss fabric selection and purchase our fabric for the top, back, and binding.

Syllabus:

- **Class #1** – Basic sewing skills, fabric selection, use of rotary cutter and rulers, squaring of fabric, cutting WOF strips, sewing strips, pressing seams, and constructing basic NINE-PATCH block.
Homework: Sewing of all NINE-PATCH blocks
- **Class #2** – Creating new DISAPPEARING NINE-PATCH blocks; pressing, cutting, repositioning, sewing, and pressing seams. Squaring up of new block.
Homework: Finish all new blocks and squaring up.
- **Class #3** – Layout of quilt and assembly of quilt top. Measuring, cutting, and assembly of quilt backing, practice with scraps calculating/cutting/sewing quilt binding using mitered corners, calculating/cutting of quilt binding, batting selection, quilting options
