

Jack O'Lantern Placemat supply list

Pattern: Jack O'Lantern Placemat by Jackie Vujcich

This pattern gives yardage to make **four** placemats that are approximately 14" x 18".

Fabric

Background (blue) - 1/3 yard

Outer Border (black) – 2/3 yard

Oranges (4 to 6 different oranges) – 12" square of EACH orange

Green- 4" square

Eyes/mouth (optional) black - 8" x 8" (only need if adding eyes, nose & mouth)

Batting: 30" x 40"

Backing: 1 yard

Binding (optional): 2/3 yard

Notions:

Rotary cutter (optional: appropriate blades & Rotary cutting mat)

6" x 6" acrylic quilt ruler (optional: 12"x 12" or larger-an 18" square would be ideal acrylic ruler)

Fusible web (such as Wonder Under lite) 8" x 8" (only needed if adding eyes/mouth)

Applique pressing sheet (only needed if adding eyes/mouth)

2 pieces of computer paper

Thread- a neutral color for piecing; colors to match fabric for quilting

Pins, seam ripper, machine needles, sharp scissors

Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget the foot controller and plug)-it must be capable of sewing an accurate 1/4" seam

Pre-class "homework" instructions: Prior to class, please cut one 15" x 19" from backing and batting.
