

On the Border Supply list
With Jackie Vujcich

In this full-day technique workshop, you'll learn speed piecing techniques for 8- 10 borders and the mathematics associated with them will be discussed.

Handout: Please have \$5 for Jackie at beginning of class (for gathering, writing and printing)

Fabric: Since this is an improv class where you'll be designing as you go. Please cut the following squares and strips width of fabric (WOF) -from selvedge to selvedge PRIOR to the workshop. You can choose coordinating fabrics or they can be just those ugly fabrics that you don't have a use for anymore! Each color value (light, medium and dark) can be from the same fabric OR you can use many fabrics as long as you can put them into the light, medium, dark category. Please bring a little extra fabric of each value for "goofs".

Light-colored fabric: two 6 ½" squares, eight 4" squares, three 2 ½" x WOF strips, three 1 ½" x WOF strips

Medium colored fabric: two 6 ½" squares, two 2 ½" x WOF strips, three 1 ½" x WOF strip, one 2"x WOF strip

Dark fabric: Two 7 ¼" squares, four 6" squares, one 2 ½" x WOF strip, three 1 ½" x WOF strip, two 2 ¼" x WOF strips

Notions:

Sewing machine in working order with ¼" foot (don't forget cords, foot controls) and extension cords if needed.

Sewing tools (scissors, seam ripper, pins, thread etc.)

Rulers (small square such as 6" or 6 ½" and 6" x 24")

Rotary cutter and mat

Optional:

Starch (you may want to do this prior to the workshop)

If you have a quilt that you'd like some border advice with, bring it to the workshop. (Due to time constraints, one per person please.)
