

Paper Piecing Technique-tulip supply list

Required Pattern: Paper-piecing Tulips Made Easy by Jackie Vujcich
\$5 for the pattern/handout due to Jackie at the beginning of class please.

Fabrics:

Blue (sky) – 1 fat quarter (or your choice for a background color)
Border (color of choice) – 1 fat quarter
Terra cotta (pot) – 9” x 9” square
Pink or Red (flower) – 1 fat quarter (or your choice of color for the flower)
Green (leaf/stem) – 12” x 12” square
Flower center – 4” x 4” square your choice of color

Notions:

Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget the foot controller and plug)
Thread- neutral (beige or gray)
Seam ripper, pins, scissors
Rotary cutter, additional blades
Clear quilting ruler 6” x 24”
Freezer paper – 1 yard

Optional Notions: (These are VERY helpful but not absolutely necessary.)

Open-toed foot
6” x 6” quilting ruler
Sewing machine needle –used or dull
Add a ¼ Ruler
