

Simple Sewn Circles Supply List

This technique class will cure your fear of sewing curves with painless, pinless, piecing. You can sew a circle in 10 minutes

Suggested book: Pieced Curves So Simple by Dale Fleming

Fabric:

Since this is a technique class, please bring any (good quality-ugly or coordinates!) fabric in the following amounts:

Fabric #1 -1/2 yard

Fabric #2 1/4 yard

Fabric #3 1/4 yard

Fabric #4 1/4 yard

Fabric #5 1/4 yard

Notions:

Sewing machine in good working order and usual sewing notions

Cotton Thread- a neutral color

Paper and fabric scissors

Open-toed (applique) sewing machine foot

Freezer paper – 1 1/2 yds

Water soluble Glue stick or Roxane Glue Baste It

Acrylic quilt ruler 12 1/2" square (optional)

snack or lunch

Pre-class “homework” instructions: From EACH 1/4 yard fabric, cut two 8 3/4” squares. From the 1/2 yard fabric, cut one 16 1/2” square. From the freezer paper cut two 8 3/4” squares and two 16 1/2” squares.
